## DAILY CAMP SCHEDULE

8:00–8:30am	Morning drop-off
8:30am–12:30pm	Morning Camp

## AGES 6-8

**June 24-28**

### **AM Camp: Ancient Pottery and Painting**

Students take inspiration from the Museum's antiquities collections to create ceramic and painted artwork to treasure for ages.

### **PM Camp: Art & Digital Flow**

Expand your art vocabulary and get into the flow of creating artworks through drawing, collage, painting, and digital techniques.

**June 3-7**

### **AM Camp: Mixed Media Fun**

Explore the Museum collections while creating your own mixed media masterpieces. Finding inspiration in antiquity and contemporary art, students will explore a variety of materials to make their mark.

### **PM Camp: Mosaic Masters**

Work your puzzler brain creating artworks with mosaic techniques. Be inspired by works on view in our antiquities and contemporary collections and create masterful designs out of clay, glass, paper, and more.

**June 10-14**

### **AM Camp: Embellishment Aficionado**

Enter your maximalist era and be inspired by the vivid artwork in *Embellish Me: Works from the Collection of Norma Canelas Roth and William Roth*. Create eclectic projects using pattern, mixed media, and fiber arts.

### **PM Camp: Photography: Created Worlds**

Photography is not just about capturing the world around us but also about creating imaginary worlds. In this camp, students will create everything that goes into the image: from telling stories to creating miniature scenes.

### **AM Camp: Lil' Printmaking Pros**

Make your mark exploring a variety of printmaking techniques. Create imagery inspired by works on view at the Museum and explore printmaking methods including cyanotype, linocut and more.

### **PM Camp: Lil' Sculpture Superstars**

Students create their own sculptures in clay and mixed media materials with guided projects inspired by collections on view at the Museum.

**July 8-12**

### **AM Camp: Heroes & Villains**

Get inspired by the visual storytelling and epic tales in the antiquities collection to make your own dynamic mixed media artwork. Imagine dynamic villains, equip your hero with a custom shield, make a treasure map to guide your adventure, and more.

### **PM Camp: Painting Prelude**

Make painting projects inspired by the paintings on display at the Museum, including paintings of ancient creatures in the antiquities collection, abstract paintings from *Prelude: An Introduction to the Permanent Collection*, and the work of artist Purvis Young.

**July 15-19**

### **AM Camp: Upcycled Art**

Use recycled and repurposed materials to make art inspired by current exhibitions at the Museum. Create unique works of art while helping to preserve the environment by reusing and recycling everyday materials you could find at home.

### **PM Camp: Heroes & Villains**

Get inspired by the visual storytelling and epic tales in the antiquities collection to make your own dynamic mixed media artwork. Imagine dynamic villains, equip your hero with a custom shield, make a treasure map to guide your adventure, and more.

**July 22-26**

### **AM Camp: Expanded Photography**

In *Expanded Photography*, students will explore a variety of ways to embrace the art of photography. Students learn digital and manual manipulation, and other experimental approaches to photography.

### **PM Camp: Let it Grow**

Green thumbs go beyond the garden in this nature inspired art camp. Students will create projects for and about things that grow. Clay planters, mixed media cactus sculptures, plant stakes, and more will be created with inspiration taken from works exhibited in the galleries.

## AGES 9-12

**June 3-7**

### **AM Camp: Digital Character Design**

Students explore figure drawing, collage, and other digital art techniques to develop an original character design inspired by works in the Museum's exhibits. Bring your character to life and take home the beginning of your next epic tale.

### **PM Camp: Mixed Media Fun**

### **AM Camp: Tales Illustrated**

Students create their own illustrated book in this camp made for all stages of story tellers. Create your narrative and bring your story to life through multi-media art techniques.

### **PM Camp: Ancient Pottery and Painting**

Students take inspiration from the Museum's antiquities collections to create ceramic and painted artwork to treasure for ages.

**July 8-12**

### **AM Camp: Digital Animators**

Learn digital medium from the beginning and create artwork on the iPad Pro. Student will use Procreate and Adobe Fresco to create illustrations, paintings, and animations.

### **PM Camp: Sculpture Safari**

Go on an art making safari! Create 3D animals in ceramic and mixed media sculpture while learning about animal representation in exhibitions on view at the Museum.

**July 15-19**

### **PM Camp: Upcycled Art**

Use recycled and repurposed materials to make art inspired by current exhibitions at the Museum. Create unique works of art while helping to preserve the environment by reusing and recycling everyday materials you could find at home.

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### **PM Camp: Sticker Makers**

In this digital drawing course students will explore color theory, design principles, and new techniques while creating their own set of images to be printed as stickers.

In this open studio format, students will meet and work with guest artists while being guided by a main mentor to further explore their artistic interests and to branch out to new approaches.
