Educational Programs for Children and Young Adults

We offer **free, docent-led tours** for all K-12 public, private and home schooled students in Hillsborough County introducing students to art appreciation; encouraging critical thinking skills; and fostering the ability to make historical and cultural connections.

The Museum presents student **art exhibitions and receptions** throughout the school year, highlighting the young talent in our community, from elementary to high school.

The Museum hosts **Teacher Previews** for all Hillsborough County public and private school educators to visit and to learn how our exhibitions can complement their lesson plans.

NEW! Summer & Fall Studio Art Courses

We work with professional teachers and active artists in the Tampa Bay area to provide engaging studio art classes for adults. We now offer two locations, the Museum and The Roberta M Golding Visual Art Center at the Bryan Glazer Family Jewish Community Center, operated by the City of Tampa. These courses are presented in partnership with Hillsborough County and the City of Tampa Parks & Recreation.



Art Spot is a free, Saturday morning drop-in program where kids and their families let their imaginations run free while they make art together. Facilitators introduce exhibition specific methods of art making that bring out the creativity in everyone. **No two Saturday's are ever alike!**

The Tampa Museum of Art's **Youth Council** is creating an accessible museum environment for youth in our community to express themselves artistically. The newly formed Youth Council has been busy designing Teen Programs for the 2016-17 school year, striving to engage, educate, and excite youth in arts.

Community Outreach and Access

Art Space collaborates with community organizations to provide quality engagement with the visual arts for economically and environmentally disadvantaged youths and adults. Our amazing partners include The Spring, Redefining Refuge, and the PACE Center for Girls.

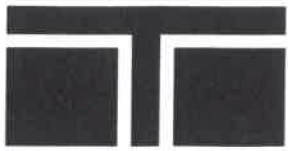
Connections is a mental healthcare community art engagement program for those experiencing Dementia, Alzheimer's disease, Depression, Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, and other stressors in life. This program is presented in partnership with the Tampa Bay Foundation for Mental Health and the University of South Florida Honors College.

We continue to offer **Free Admission for all University and College students** throughout the year.

Art on the House offers pay-as-you-will admission on Fridays from 4 - 10 pm. More than 20% of our guests visit during these hours!

The Museum regularly offers **Family Days** with children's activities, live entertainment, tours, and pay-as-you-will admission for families to enjoy a fun day out together.





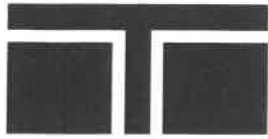
